Title of the Research: "**Occupational morbidity in a Garment Manufacturing Industry**"

- The study was conducted with the objectives of enlisting and describing common occupation related morbidities.
- A total of 362 employees were examined and the important morbidities noted were musculoskeletal disorders (22.1%), refractive errors (14.4%), skin disorders (9.9%) and respiratory illnesses (6.1%)
- Of the employees 74 (20.4%) were underweight with a B.M.I of less than 18.5.
- The occupational groups examined mainly consisted of tailors, helpers, checkers, cutters, trimmers, supervisors and those on the ironing and finishing departments

- ⇒ The study was conducted during the month of May-June, 2009, in the department of Community Medicine under the guidance of Dr. K. K. Dutta Gupta M.D., DIH, Professor and HOD, Department of Community Medicine.
